3:50 to 6:00pm - All students and parents are welcome to attend the fair and optional workshops:

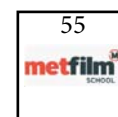
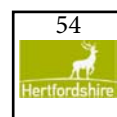
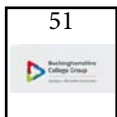
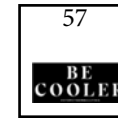
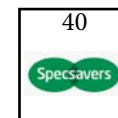
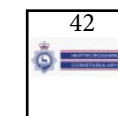
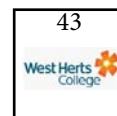
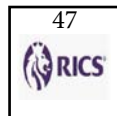
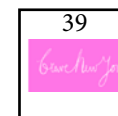
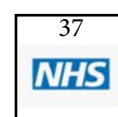
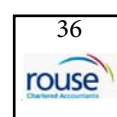
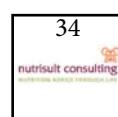
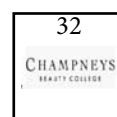
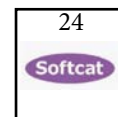
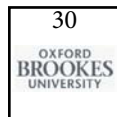
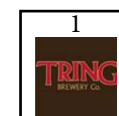
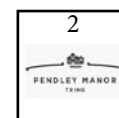
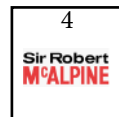
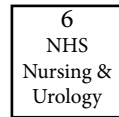
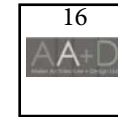
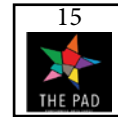
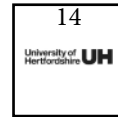
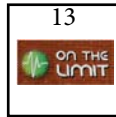
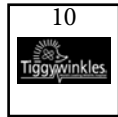
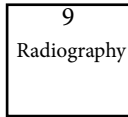
