## Educational Visits Behaviour Contract



Health and Safety is a critical part of organising an Educational visit which we, as a school, take very seriously. We therefore require the assurance of the parent and the student that they will adhere to the following:

1. To behave sensibly and considerately at all times
2. To follow and respect the decisions and instructions made by staff
3. To not drink alcohol at any time
4. To not smoke at any time
5. To not take drugs, except for medical reasons
6. To adhere to single sex sleeping arrangements
7. To understand that the school cannot accept responsibility for the security of personal possessions such as mobile phones, cameras and other electronic equipment

You need also to be aware that at certain times students may not be under the direct supervision of an accompanying adult. In these situations students are to remain in 'buddy' groups of no less than three.

Students will always be informed of meeting times and a designated point of contact where an adult will be present.

It is in the interest of your child's health and safety that the above code of conduct is respected.

In the event of a serious behaviour incident before the visit your child may forgo their right to participate on the visit which will in most cases result in forfeiting any monies paid.

In the event of a serious behaviour incident on the visit it is possible that we may feel the need to send your child home or implement other appropriate sanctions. In these circumstances the parent/guardian will be wholly responsible for the resulting financial implications.

Poor behaviour on any visit could jeopardise future participation in other school visits.
