










Philippa Gregory's books

The Cousins' War series – great background reading about the War of the Roses and into the reign of Henry VII

- ❖ The White Queen (Elizabeth Woodville)
- ❖ The Red Queen (About Margaret Beaufort – Henry VII's mother)
- ❖ The Kingmaker's Daughter (Isabel and Anne Neville)
- ❖ The White Princess (Elizabeth of York – marries Henry VII)
- ❖ The King's Curse (Margaret Pole)

The Tudor Court Novels

- ❖ The Constant Princess (Catherine of Aragon)
- ❖ The Other Boleyn Girl (Mary and Anne Boleyn)
- ❖ The Boleyn Inheritance (Jane Boleyn, Anne of Cleves and Katherine Howard)

Hilary Mantel's books

These are brilliant books, but they are not as easy to read to as CJ Sansom or Philippa Gregory, they may be books to read when you are half-way through the course – as you will then have more understanding of what is going on and you'll appreciate the wealth of detail more.

- ❖ Wolf Hall - the story of Thomas Cromwell, during Henry's divorce, the fall of Wolsey and the Break with Rome
- ❖ Bring up the Bodies - takes up Cromwell's story where Wolf Hall finishes and deals with the fall of Anne Boleyn 1535 – 1536
