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Dear Year 12 Parents/Carers,

We hope you are well and your child is looking forward to a well-deserved rest after an extraordinary year. Year 12 students have been working incredibly hard to keep up with the work in their subjects and I want to take the time to thank you for supporting them, and us, in this endeavour.

We wish to provide you with some additional information about the support for Year 12, soon to be 13, in school, and the plans for the next academic year. Students have been emailed the arrangements for the start of the next academic year already. However, I have attached this information [here](#) so you are aware of what will happen too.

The vast majority of Year 13 students will be studying in school for lessons only in September. They are permitted to take home study when they do not have lessons. This is a departure from our usual procedure and is an arrangement in place because of Covid-19 restrictions on space and distancing.

We would like to make sure we set clear expectations for working from home. Students will come to school on Monday 7 September for a year group assembly and group appointments. Following this, during the first week of term, students will be engaging with material set on Google Classroom in a similar fashion as they have done this term until Friday 11 September, when lessons in school will commence. Please can I ask that you ensure you check Go4Schools to see if any 'Google Hangout Sessions' have been missed or if 'Classwork has not been seen'. Teachers will be logging to ensure both students and parents are aware.

It is also essential that students, when working from home, are committing their time to their studies as we would expect in school. We will be asking students to re-sign the Six Expectations Form they signed at the start of Year 12, as well as a Working from Home Agreement. This will further outline our expectations and enable students to be clear in what is expected of them from both the Sixth Form Team and their teachers. The working day for all students should start at 8.40 am, regardless of when their lessons take place. There is a large degree of trust placed upon students in order to work at home, however, we know that as young adults they will rise to the challenge of taking full responsibility for their home learning.

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We are hoping that all students will be able to return to studying in school full time after the October half-term break. However, if you feel that your child would benefit from working in school in study periods from September, or are unable to easily return home after lessons, please do not hesitate to get in touch.

We wish to take this opportunity to thank you for your ongoing support and we look forward to welcoming students back in the Autumn Term. They have worked incredibly hard to ensure they are keeping up with their studies. Summer work is likely to be provided for different subjects but please also encourage your child to use that time to relax and unwind too. There is a well-being classroom that Miss Moore has posted brilliant activities on for every single day during lockdown and so a wealth of resources are available to help students look after their wellbeing. We're proud of all of their efforts to complete work and manage their time in these most challenging of circumstances.
