## Extended Learning Day 3

On **Tuesday 6 July** your child will experience the final Extended Learning Days of this academic school year. The sessions delivered on these days complement the learning that takes place in subject lessons and requires your child to apply their skills in new and different situations. Integral to this has been our Character programme which requires students to utilise the skills of communication, curiosity, determination and independence. The programme is as follows:

### **Year 7 - Chessington Visit - J. Sanday**

*A team bonding visit to Chessington Theme Park*

### **Year 8 - Willen Lake - L. Bullock**

*A range of exciting outdoor water based activities to include canoeing, water skiing, wake boarding etc.*

### **Year 9 - Globe Shakespeare Trip - V. Johnston**

*Theatre trip to London to support current lesson work on 'context' in the lead up to their GCSE English Literature course*

### **Year 9 - English – non theatre students – L. Fleming**

*Romeo and Juliet related English sessions for students not going on the trip*

### **Year 10 - History London Dungeons Visit – P. du Bois**

*A visit to the London Dungeons for historians.*

### **Year 10 - Geography Fieldwork – L. Jones**

*River Chess fieldwork (Geography students only)*

### **Year 10 - Go Ape – L. Toovey**

*An opportunity to develop team building skills; sessions will include the treetop adventure, team games and an outdoor escape room*

### **Year 12 - Go Ape or Walk – C. Belony/E. Browne**

*An opportunity to get physically active; whether this be climbing in the trees at Go Ape or completing a walk through Ashridge. Students not participating in these, will complete independent study at Tring School*

### **Year 7, 8 & 10 non visit students - A. Sharp**

*Students will complete activities following the 'tea trail.' Students will watch a documentary, design an itinerary and t-shirts to visit countries who grow tea.*
