Dear Parents/Carers

It has been an absolute pleasure to welcome Year 7 and Year 12 students into school this week.

Both Year Groups looked exceptionally smart and conducted themselves in a very mature manner. They were introduced to the 'Working Safely at Tring School Guide', and very quickly demonstrated how adaptable they are to a new way of operating.

With over 1750 staff and students working in a tight environment, it is crucial that all students and staff take full responsibility for their own actions. I am asking students to have an awareness of how their actions/behaviour can impact others around them.

Our new students have taken responsibility for themselves and quickly adapted to the wearing of face coverings, waiting in restricted areas at break and lunchtimes, additional handwashing and adhering to the one-way system.

A quick reminder for students who arrive next week -

- Students should have with them their own tissues, hand sanitiser and a face covering
- Students should enter the school site through their designated gates and proceed to their Year Group zone
- Students should sanitise their workspace on arrival in a classroom
- Students should bring a coat each day, as break and lunchtimes will be outside in all weather conditions
- Students will only have access to the canteen to purchase food once per day

To clarify, buses will only be running in the morning and end of the school day. Families are required to make arrangements for mid-day transport.

**Plans for online learning have now been revised for the week commencing 7 September.** Students would normally be in school during next week, however, due to our complex situation we made the decision to provide a phased return to school. To facilitate students learning during the phased return, teachers have planned lesson material for students to complete in their own time over the week. Work will be posted on their Google classroom during their usual timetabled lessons next week. The exception to this is when students are in school for their initial sessions. Therefore, when students are in school, there will be no google classroom lesson posted for these times. This is a revised action and all
