## Head of School update

We have all had such a lovely week welcoming so many happy and smiley Year 10 and 12 students into school to meet with their teachers. They were all really genuinely happy and relieved to be back in uniform and on school site. I am very much looking forward to seeing more of them all over the next few weeks. I hope that students from year groups who have not been able to return continue to understand and appreciate our constraints with regards to their provision.

On Friday 19 June, the DfE announced that in September 2020, all students in all year groups, in all schools will return to school. This is fantastic news and such a relief to us all. What is not clear at this point is what restrictions will still be in place; will there still be social distancing guidelines; whether there will continue to be a cap on the maximum number of students allowed on-site or in a classroom at any time and the list could go on. As soon as we receive further guidance, I will share more with you. Please be prepared for a continuation of blended learning at the start of any return to school programme, as I am keen to bring students back slowly and safely to acclimatise with our new school setting and expectations.

**Key Worker holiday provision** - A welcome announcement for many, I am sure is the ability to mix with second households and the ability for students to see and stay with grandparents again. Restrictions on wraparound care have also been relaxed which will make school holiday care more achievable. We, therefore, will not be offering any on-site provision for Key Worker children but are happy to help source local provision if required.

**Years 7 - 9** - Wednesday 8 July periods 4 & 5 students will be set an enhancement project, similar to the Extended Learning Day. Students will choose one activity to complete and submit over periods 4 & 5. More information will be emailed to students next week.

**Year 8 - HPV Immunisations** - The immunisation programme in schools was suspended at the end of March following school closures. Public Health England has requested the immunisation programme continue to avoid outbreaks of vaccine-preventable diseases and provide important protection to children. The Immunisation Team are able to offer appointments on Wednesday 8 July and Thursday 9 July at Tring School. **Parents are requested to call 01727 732062 to make an appointment.**
