Head of School Update

I hope you continue to be well as we move closer to the end of the academic year, and what a year it has been! I am sure that you, as well as our students, are looking forward to a summer break away from 'home-schooling'.

When the announcement was made that schools were to close in March, I don't think any of us believed that we wouldn't return before the summer break. We have noticed that many students still have personal possessions in classrooms and lockers and we would like to request that items are collected before the summer holidays. All lockers and classrooms will be emptied and unclaimed items will be removed. Please remember that we are moving out of the Neville, Hobson and Watkins (Science) blocks and into the Modular Village over the Summer break and therefore, students will not be returning to old classrooms or lockers. If your child has belongings in school which need to be collected, please come to Reception (with your child) between 9.30 am - 2.30 pm and you will be escorted to collect the items. Any unclaimed items will be taken to the recycling centre after 17 July.

Years 7- 9 - Details of the range of Extended Learning Activities to be completed during periods 4 & 5 on Wednesday 8 July have been sent to the students' school email. Our reporting schedule has been revised and Year 7 will now receive progress data once we have returned to school in the Autumn as opposed to next week.

Year 8 - HPV Immunisations will take place in the Sports Hall on Wednesday 8 July and Thursday 9 July. Please refer to the letter sent home on 24 June for further details (this can be found on the school website). When arriving on-site, please park and enter the Sports Hall using the swimming pool entrance.

Year 11 and 13 - will receive a letter next week regarding Exam Results Days and the methodology used to calculate their Centre Assessed Grade.
