Virtual Induction

I trust that you have found our Transition Website informative and useful in helping your child(ren) prepare for joining us in September.

Our Taster Lessons are now available via our school website from the main menu or via this [link](#). Each subject area has created a short and enjoyable taster lesson. They include suggested activities and give your child(ren) the opportunity to experience secondary school lessons with our teachers. They will be available to access until the end of summer holidays.

Summer Induction Day - Wednesday 1 September 2021

I am now able to share confirmed plans for our Summer Induction Day on Wednesday 1 September. Our pastoral team will be leading the day, and there is a great programme of team building and getting to know you activities planned.

An Operoo form was shared last week and we already have approximately 200 confirmed students attending. If you have not yet responded, please do so by Monday 12 July when the form will close.

We request that a **lateral flow test is completed prior to attending**, and that any student with a positive result does not attend and follows the government guidelines. An Operoo form will be sent out for you to register the test results.

Your child(ren) should wear a **plain t-shirt or top in the colour of their House (no hoodies or strappy tops please)** with clothing and footwear suitable for PE.

Students will need:

- A packed lunch and a snack for break time
- A filled water bottle
- Hand sanitiser
- Sunscreen and hat
- A coat may also be advisable depending on the weather
- A face covering. These will only be necessary at times where social distancing is more difficult and will allow your child to start to become more comfortable with wearing a face covering at school.
