Year 10 - Science and Maths Study Support

As you are aware your child is part of the Science and Maths Study Support group which meets for 4 lessons per timetable cycle during option block A.

This course is designed to support the students as they work towards their GCSEs by looking at areas of the curriculum in an applied and practical way. The aim is to reinforce the work done during Science and Maths lessons using projects, experiments, data collection and research.

In order to make the lessons as engaging as possible I have planned a number of activities to various nearby locations. With the exception of the electricity power station (Greatmoor) these visits will take place during our scheduled lessons and not impact other areas of the curriculum. The Tring Museum outing will incorporate the lunch break and walk to and from the location.

We are proposing to take the students out for these activities:

11/11/20	Tring High Street Traffic survey	Data collection to lead into work on pollution and carbon footprint.
25/11/20	Tring Station	Record data and calculate the speed of a train.
9/12/20	Minibus visit to McDonalds	Plotting a distance/time graph. Application of Physics calculations.
Date to be confirmed - may not go ahead due to COVID	Minibus visit to Greatmoor, Aylesbury (all day)	Seeing first hand how electricity is produced from combustion of waste materials

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Date to be confirmed - may not go ahead due to COVID	Natural History Museum, Tring	Looking at classification and adaptation of species with regard to evolution.
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We will be either walking or taking the school minibus to travel to these locations .

There are no cost implications for these proposed visits and basic insurance cover will be arranged through the Department of Education Risk Protection Arrangement. If required a policy summary can be obtained from the Finance office. Alternatively, if additional or specialist insurance is required we suggest you contact your own insurance broker.

At all venues the students will be expected to adhere to the Coronavirus protocols. If you are happy for your child to participate in these visits could you kindly sign and return the attached reply slip to school.
