Year 12 Work Experience Update

We have been really impressed with the way students have engaged with the opportunities to complete virtual work experience this year. The engagement with these opportunities is invaluable and I know that many more students have plans to attend virtual work experience in the coming weeks. Please keep referring to [this document](#) to find opportunities, which we are updating regularly.

As restrictions start to ease, some students may be lucky enough to find physical work experience placements. We appreciate that this can be an invaluable opportunity for students wishing to pursue careers in certain sectors. We are also aware that businesses and organisations will be willing to start accepting work experience students into their environments at different stages. Therefore, rather than having a fixed, physical work experience week in July, we will authorise up to 5 days between now and the end of term in order for students to attend a physical work experience placement of their choosing. This should allow a lot more flexibility for students to find placements this year. Please note that physical work experience is not compulsory.

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Students are expected to fill in this [Work Experience Reflection Form](#) when completing their placement and if a physical placement is occurring, students will need to complete a yellow form from the Sixth Form Office as well as informing teachers of their absence and endeavouring to catch up with any work they will have missed. In addition you will need to get the [Employer Health & Safety Declaration](#) and complete the Parent Consent Form which will come to you via Operoo.
