## Year 13 History – Hampton Court – Thursday 7 October 2021

On 7 October 2021 we would like to take our Year 13 History students to Hampton Court as part of their A level History course.

### Purpose of the visit

The reign of Henry VIII (including the rise and fall of Wolsey) and the English Reformation is an important part of the syllabus and a trip to Hampton Court Palace really helps bring the whole topic to life. The students will work in groups looking at sources and have a guided tour and education session about the English Reformation. Students will also be able to explore parts of the Palace themselves in small groups.

### Transport

We will be travelling by coach, leaving from school at **8.00 am** and returning by **5.00 pm**.

### Cost of the visit

The cost of this visit will be **£37.00** per student which includes transport to and from the venue, entrance, insurance, staff and administration costs. Whilst all contributions are voluntary, if we do not receive the full payment from every student to cover the cost of this visit, we reserve the right to cancel. Any surplus will be refunded according to our Charging and Remissions Policy.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch, writing equipment and should wear warm and sensible clothing/footwear. Students should bring a waterproof jacket. We will be outside all day and it could be cold and wet!
