Dear Parent/Carer

As part of our Lifeskills lessons, Year 9 students will take part in Sexual Health and Relationships Education where they consider the changing nature of a range of relationships.

At Tring School, we continue to prepare students for the physical and emotional changes of growing up; to give them the knowledge and skills to make informed and healthy choices, to build their confidence and skills to deal with situations they may encounter and to help them to stay safe and know where and how to ask for help if needed.

As part of this year's Sexual Health and Relationships Education, your child will have a lesson which teaches about female genital mutilation (FGM). They will be taught what FGM is, the legalities surrounding it in the UK and discuss ways of how to keep safe. We believe that this will be an important addition to the Year 9 Sexual Health and Relationships Programme and will commence from April until May.
